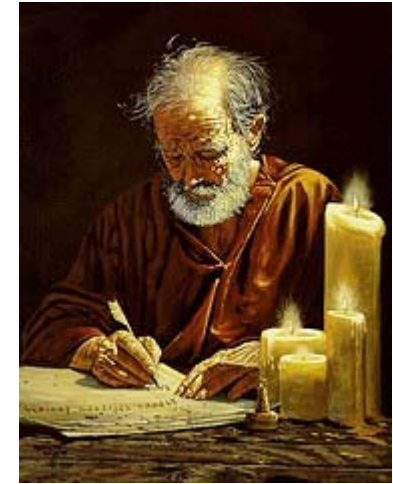
Scholarship Information

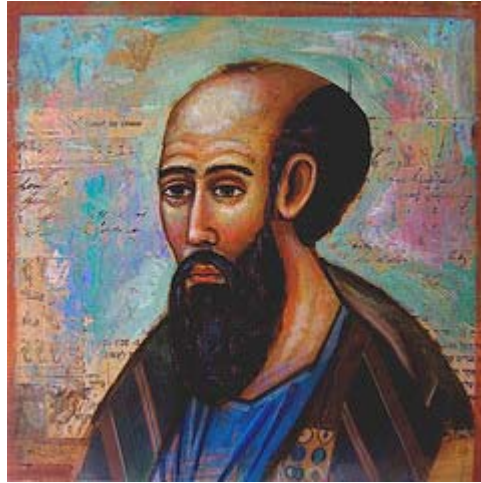
