Job Description: Choir Director/Organist

About us...

Pendleton Presbyterian Church is a “traditional” church, where the services include hymns from the Presbyterian Hymnal; where both the hymns and choir are accompanied by the organ (and piano). Occasional more modern Christian worship songs have a place within our services but are not the standard. (Specifically, this is not a “worship pastor” position and, there is no desire, at this point, to move away from a choir to a band).

General responsibilities:

Coordinate musical selections with Reverend to ensure continuity with Liturgical Calendar
Coordinate appropriate selections with church pianist

Conduct one rehearsal, per week, for adult choir (Wednesday evening 60-90 minutes)
Conduct final run-through on Sunday morning (9:30-10:00)
Sunday service (11:00-12:00)

Prepare, rehearse and present four children’s music events (Easter, Christmas + 2 other events)

Requirements:

Ability to play organ (Previous church experience desired, but ability to play competently is a must)
Ability to direct choir (Previous experience desired, but will consider little or no experience)
Ability to work with children’s groups (Previous experience desired, but will consider little or no experience)

Ability to sing and play additional instruments is a plus, but not a requirement.

Compensation

This is a salaried position that pays \$10,000 per year. There are no additional benefits.
